

Privacy Notice as to the Contact form

Pursuant to Art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (known as GDPR) D.V.P. Vacuum Technology s.p.a. is hereby providing you with the following information.

1. Purpose and legal basis

The personal data provided through the contact form on this site shall be used by D.V.P. Vacuum Technology s.p.a. to follow up on your requests.

The processing of such data does not require your consent, as it represents a legitimate interest of the Data Controller to be able to follow up on your request (Art.6, letter b) of GDPR).

The processing of the requested data is therefore optional but necessary for the purpose of formalizing your request: if you refuse to provide such data, the Company shall not be able to take your request into consideration.

2. Retention period and categories of recipients

Personal data shall be kept until reaching the purpose as described in point 1 of this privacy notice.

At the end of such processing, data shall be deleted or anonymised in the computer systems and the paper archives of the Data Controller, if any.

Personal data shall never be disclosed or communicated to any third parties, unless this is necessary to properly fulfil your request and, in any case, after advising you.

3 Data Controller, contacts and Data Subject's rights

The Data Controller is D.V.P. Vacuum Technology s.p.a., with registered office at Via Rubizzano 627 – 40018 San Pietro in Casale (BO), Italy. Pursuant to Articles 15 to 22 of the GDPR regulation, the Data Subject is entitled to:

- obtain from the Data Controller the access, rectification and erasure of his/her personal data;
- obtain the updating or, if interested, integration of data;
- obtain the anonymisation or blocking of any data processed in violation of the law, including those that do not need to be retained for the purposes for which they were collected or subsequently processed;
- obtain the limitation of the processing of his/her data or object to their processing;
- exercise his/her right to data portability.

The Data Subject may also lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority (such as the data protection authority).
